Pastor's View

Dear Siblings in Christ,

First, I promise you that I wrote this before I went on leave! I would also like to take a moment to extend my thanks and deep appreciation once again for all of the care and support all of you have given to Stephen and me as we have transitioned into parenthood. It is a true gift and a true witness to experience the love of God in Christ through all of you in this way. Thank you, thank you, thank you!

Speaking of witness, to wrap up the year for the adult education class I have given them a series of questions to discuss that relate to witnessing to our faith in the world. The Easter season is an exceptionally great time to talk about witnessing to our faith in the world! This is the time of year where we read a lot from the book of Acts and hear how the early disciples witnessed to Christ's resurrection and how the early church came to be. Furthermore, how would any of us know about Easter, the resurrection, or Jesus if it wasn't for the women who first shared the good news, if it wasn't for the early disciples who shared the good news with all of the world, and if it wasn't for key people in our lives who shared the good news with us so that we would believe and have life and hope in Jesus Christ? This need not be something big or grandiose, but can be as small as saying hello to someone we don't know.

Jesus is always meeting us where we are at and meeting us in new ways with the promise of his love for us so that we might be that love in new and familiar ways for others. Thanks be to God for all the witnesses of the resurrection who have shared the story and love of Jesus with us. And thanks be to God for all of you who witness to the love of Christ every day and share the story of Jesus in all that you say and do.

Pastor's Report

- All services of Lent, Holy Week, and Easter went well and were well attended.
- Everything is organized for Sunday worship and homebound visits during maternity leave.
- ➤ Officiated at the funeral service of Joan Shelton on Friday, March 24, at Faith.
- ➤ Confirmation will be May 21 at Faith. Pastor Leah will conduct both services that Sunday.
- ➤ Those who had been meeting for morning coffee at Steffens are getting together Monday through Friday morning at Faith.
- ➤ Working with Jason and Marsha on bulletins and the weekly email in the absence of a parish secretary.

God Squad

- ➤ 8 youth and their friends bowled at DeWitt Lanes on March 26.
- > Served breakfast and conducted an egg hunt following Easter worship at Our Savior's.
- ➤ Youth-led service will be April 23 at Faith. Designated the loose offering for the Ronald McDonald House in Iowa City.
