Pastor Writes



It happened purely by accident, just yesterday, which was a Sunday.

My communion assistants at Our Savior's came forward at the same time as usual, when the offering is presented, and sat down in their usual spots and waited for the communion liturgy to begin, just like usual. So far, nothing at all out of the ordinary had happened. But things began to take an interesting turn when little David Burke, who had been helping his dad Dan collect the offering, was sent back to his seat to sit with his mom Cindy.

He began to cry when he reached the pew (unbeknownst to me, he had actually smacked his head on the baptismal font on his way to the pew, which was partially, if not entirely, the reason for his tears). But I thought he was protesting being sent back to his pew rather than staying with his dad to help with communion. This would fit the little guy's character, because not only does David help collect the offering, but he also helps ring the bell, and he *also* helps lead the children's sermon. Yes, *lead*.

So, before beginning the communion liturgy, I discretely whispered to Dan, "If David wants to stand next to you during communion, that is fine with me." Dan beckoned to David, who scurried to his side in five seconds flat, wiping his tears away What I thought had been a clever maneuver on my part in keeping the peace during communion turned out, in fact, to be much, much more.

It became an incarnational/sacramental experience.

(Two big words, separated only by a slash. Let me explain.)

You well know by now that little children are welcome to come forward for communion. They may receive a blessing if they wish, but most reach

out their hands to receive the bread. Each little outstretched hand gets a piece of bread, and I say the words, "With this bread, remember that Jesus loves you." In this way, the little ones participate in the sacrament, even if only by way of "practicing." It is meaningful to them, and to me.

Even so, when I give them their bread, I usually only bend slightly so as to look them in the eye; I look down at them, they look up at me. But yesterday, with little David standing between myself and his dad, the little ones had someone their size to look at. Twice, there was even a little high-five. Several times, there were smiles passed between the little ones, as they came up and encountered *one of their own*, someone *just like them* standing up there....someone they could relate to...someone their own size who could look them straight in the eye, them not looking up, no one looking down at them.

I found myself glancing down at these interactions with increasing curiosity and joy. *This* is why Jesus came to live among us instead is just staying up in heaven. He came to our earth to become one of us, so that we could experience the holy in terms we could understand. This is God's word incarnate—his love all wrapped up in flesh just like ours, one who looks just like us. And his is the flesh we eat in the sacrament of Holy Communion, the flesh of Jesus, who came to earth and became human, just like us.

But up until yesterday, I could never figure out a way to really explain that to little ones, because it's a pretty heady concept. What words to use to explain the incarnation of Jesus Christ and the real presence of his body in Holy Communion? Maybe there are no words. Maybe the best explanation is simply a presence. Little eyes (Continued on next page)

meeting little eyes, little hands high-fiving little hands, little feet, the same size, little fingers putting bread into little mouths...little ones not only practicing for a future communion, but actually experiencing the holy in their own way, wordlessly, simply by being represented during the distribution, by seeing one of their own as part of the sacred mix up front...of coming up and discovering *one who is just like me*.

What started out as a simple attempt to stop David from crying turned out to be a monumental realization that what we say in this place, we really mean. *All people* are welcome to come forward when the body and blood of Jesus are distributed. Jesus came to this earth to love all people, grown-ups and little ones alike, and David's three-year-old body standing right next to me during communion drove that point home like never before.



- ▶ Meeting called to order by President Dan Burke.
- ▶ Pastor Sarah led devotions.
- ▶ Budget had been approved by Council and was to be referred to on own time.
- ▶ Pastor Sarah reviewed her written report.
- A new church directory is being worked on.
- ▶ Pastor Sarah asked for feedback on her mentoring Vicar Michelle at St. John Lutheran and said she will be mentoring the new vicar for next year.
- ▶ Budget change Pastor Sarah is resuming fulltime status.
- ▶ 2013 Proposed Budget accepted.
- ▶ Mark Olson and Brian Bousselot were approved for a second term on Our Savior's Council.
- ▶ Nominating Committee will remain the same.
- ▶ Delegates are needed for the Southeastern Iowa Synod Assembly on May 31 – June 1 being held in Des Moines.
- ▶ Outreach funding outside of the church was up 10%.
- ▶ As of January 1, 2013, there will be new renters in the parsonage.

- ▶ President Mark Witte called the meeting to order.
- ▶ Pastor Sarah led devotions.
- ▶ 2012 annual meeting minutes were approved.
- ▶ Pastor Sarah reviewed her report and said she would like to focus on Christian Outreach this year.
- ▶ Property and Management reported several completed projects and all loans paid on projects: parsonage remodel and paid loan; stained glass restoration; new roof on parsonage and garage; boiler repair and new ceiling fans in sanctuary. Air conditioning will be installed this year with almost all of the money towards the purchase and installation having already been received.
- ▶ Marsha Witte reported the Lutheran Church Women contributed \$350 to Wartburg Seminary and \$350 to Churchwide Women's Outreach.
- ▶ Financial reports were approved with the treasurer reported the parsonage loan had been paid in a record amount of time while still maintaining our contribution to the ELCA Benevolent Fund.
- ▶ Auditing Committee reported everything in order and applauded Yale Christensen and Doreen Henning on the great job they do.
- ▶ Approval was given to the 2013 Proposed Budget.
- ▶ Hal Shelton was elected to serve a second 3-year term on council and Eric Hoffman was elected to serve a first 3-year term/
- ▶ 2013 Nominating Committee will be represented by Gary Braet, Yale Christensen, Mike Tendall and Mark Witte.
- ▶ Eric and Joyce Sands agreed to serve as congregational representatives on the Parish Coordinating Committee.
- ▶ Joyce and Eric Sands will serve as delegates to the Southeastern Iowa Synod Assembly at Hope Lutheran Church, Des Moines on May 31-June 1, 2013.

Dear Church friends,

I am once again participating in the Avon Walk for Breast Cancer. taking place this June 1-2 through the streets of Chicago. This weekend-



long event consists of walking 26 miles on Saturday, spending the night in a tent, and walking 13 miles on Sunday. As a participant in the walk, I have committed to raise a minimum of \$1,800. The walk will involve major physical training and significant fundraising, and am asking for your help.
