At the December Council Meetings

Joint Council:

- ➤ Pastor announced Synod Assembly will be held on May 19—20, 2017 at Lutheran Church of Hope in Des Moines.
- ➤ Worship Committee supported Pastor's request to approach Joint Council regarding the Lenten services format: three area pastors who will prepare two sermons and rotate between the three churches; drafted the annual report from the Worship Committee.
- ➤ Christian Outreach Committee served approximately 50 people at the Thanksgiving meal; bowling may be scheduled for February or March.
- ➤ Education Committee reported Sunday School students will present "Gift of Love" on December 18; in January, Sharyl Bousselot will begin serving on the committee as Marsha Witte leaves the committee.
- ➤ PCC has developed a job description for the church secretary position. In general, the position will be 20—25 hours per week, have an annual salary of \$14,000, require applications be received by January 12, 2017, and schedule training to begin March 2017. (Because of cancelled services and a late newsletter, the application date has been delayed until January 31, 2017).
- ➤ Committee reports are due in the church office by December 20, 2016 and financial reports are due by January 20, 2017.
- ➤ The council accepted the PCC 2017 salary proposal for Pastor to be presented to members at the annual meetings.

Faith Council:

- Approved financial reports with a designated balance of \$1,685.69 and a working balance of \$44,146.19.
- ➤ Window repair is tabled until bids are received from Dane.
- > Braet has repaired the church basement refrigerator.
- ➤ Braet thawed a frozen pipe in the parsonage basement; cracked foundation will be addressed with siding is installed.

Our Savior's Council:

- Approved financial reports with a balance of \$3,460.79.
