Pastor's View

I am pleased to welcome Pastor Roberta Pierce to the Calamus Lutheran Parish. She will serve as our interim pastor starting February 1, 2020. Pastor Pierce has served in various capacities in the Lutheran church before becoming an ordained minister. She served as the church secretary and volunteer coordinator at St. Andrew Lutheran Church in Cedar Rapids. Pastor Pierce was then called by Bishop Philip Hougen to become his administrative assistant at the Southeastern Iowa Synod office. She worked in that capacity for twelve years. After Bishop Hougen retired, Pastor Pierce embarked on a new and challenging career and enrolled at Wartburg Seminary. After completing her studies, she did her internship in northern North Dakota at a three-point parish. Pastor Pierce was then called to Zion Lutheran Church in Fairview, Montana, where she served for seven years. She has retired and returned to Marion, Iowa. Pastor Pierce will be in Calamus on Sundays and Wednesdays, unless an additional need arises.

Pastor Paul Ostrem, assistant to the bishop, attended the December 12 joint council meeting at Our Savior's. At that meeting, he suggested Pastor Roberta Pierce be considered as interim for our parish. The Parish Coordinating Committee met with her on January 6 and decided to recommend her to the joint councils. At the January 16 meeting, the joint councils voted to extend an invitation to Pastor Pierce to serve as our interim pastor. She agreed to work in Calamus two days a week and will do her preparation work at her home. Pastor Ostrem said the synod is searching for candidates to become our full-time pastor.


